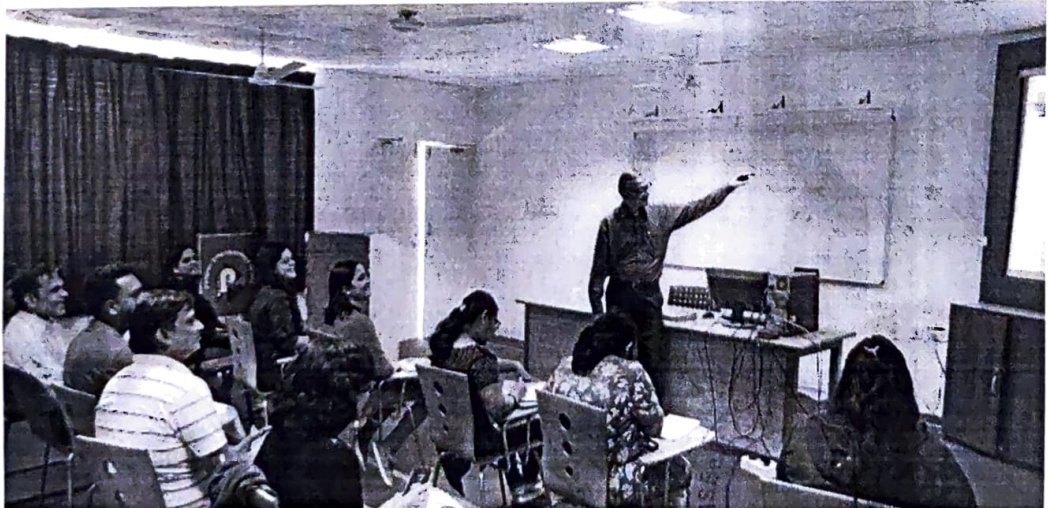
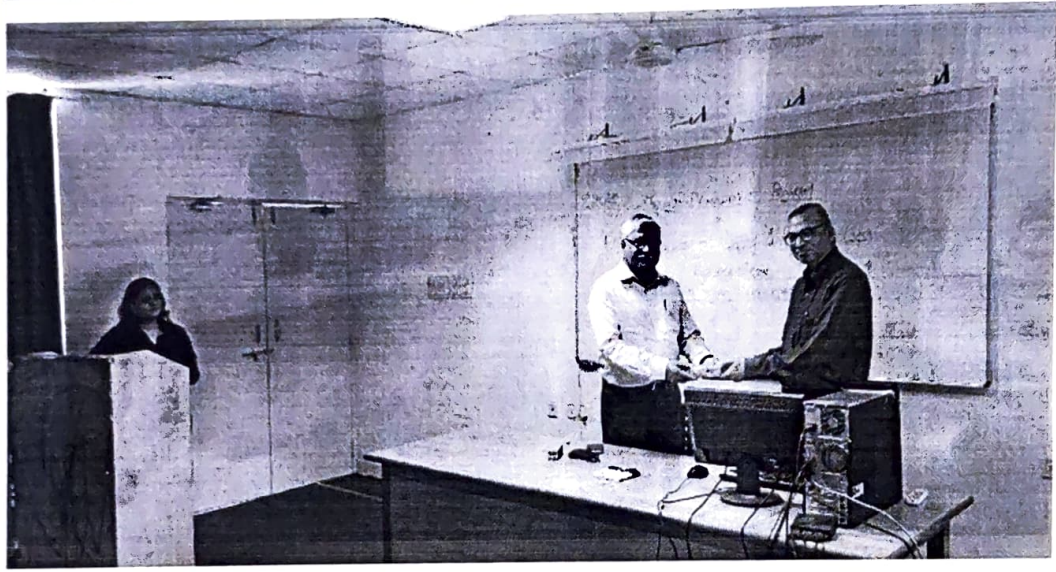
VALEDICTORY SESSION:
